VIOLATIONS NOTED

1. Observed potentially hazardous food stored in the temperature danger zone.
2. Observed ready-to-eat potentially hazardous food with expired dates.
3. The sides of cooking equipment, inside of cooling units, cabinets, counter tops, and walls around food prep areas dirty to sight and touch.
4. Dry storage room appeared to be cluttered with un-used equipment and unnecessary items.
5. The bar dish machine did not reach the proper hot water sanitizing temperature.

ACTIONS TAKEN OR ORDERED

1. Adjust thermostats on cooling units to hold food below 41 degrees F. Do not overfill cooling units with food to allow proper airflow and cooling of food.
2. Once opened, ready-to-eat food must be dated, used and discarded within seven days or used and discarded by the use-by-date. Operator was ordered to discard approximately 12 pounds of expired food.
3. Clean equipment, counters, cooling units, and walls around food prep areas routinely to prevent accumulation of food debris and residue. Clean food contact surfaces daily.
4. Remove unnecessary items from dry storage to enable proper cleaning of dry storage.
5. Repair dish machine to reach proper sanitizing temperature of 160 degrees F.

SANITARIAN'S SUMMARY OF INSPECTION

Bar area kept clean to sight and touch at the time of inspection . Walk-in cooler holding at proper temperature. Manager voluntarily discarded unsafe food at the time of inspection. A follow-up inspection will be conducted in 7 days to ensure all violations have been corrected.
