Walk in cooler, freezer, and deli cooler holding cold food below 41°F. No hot food during inspection. Hot water adequate. Kitchen kept clean and orderly. Sanitizer and test strips available. Operator has been repairing lights when needed.

(Critical) 03.4 Food: Limitation of Growth of Organisms of Public Health Concern

(F) Time/temperature controlled for safety food - hot and cold holding.

Food held in small reach cooler holding between 46°F and 47°F and in temperature danger zone. Thermostat was adjusted to hold food below 41°F. Hold all cold tcs food below 41°F to limit growth of microorganisms that may cause illness.

(KK) Food equipment - certification and classification.

Small residential style reach cooler in use. Remember, residential style equipment must be replaced with commercial grade, nsf or equivalent equipment by March 1, 2011.
