VIOLATIONS NOTED

1. Observed a residential style refrigerator and freezer used in the facility.
2. Observed no thermometers in the refrigerator.
3. Observed no covered receptacle in the women's restroom.
4. Observed wet wiping cloths stored out of sanitizer.
5. Observed bartender smoking inside of the facility.

ACTIONS TAKEN OR ORDERED

1. Once the residential style refrigerator and freezer are removed from the facility, they must be replaced with approved, commercial units.
2. Properly operating thermometers must be placed in all units that cold holding potentially hazardous food.
3. A covered receptacle must be placed in the women's restroom.
4. The wiping cloths must be stored in sanitizer when not in use.
5. The smoking must immediately cease inside of the facility.
