Follow-up inspection conducted. The following violations have been corrected:

1. Single use gloves available to prevent bare hand contact with ready-to-eat food.
2. Observed an employee washing hands between tasks.
3. Hand sink kept clean
4. Hoods have been cleaned, tables in dining area kept clean, shelves kept clean. Continue cleaning facilities routinely to prevent such accumulation of debris.

03.4 Food: Limitation of Growth of Organisms of Public Health Concern

(E) Cooling methods - temperature and time control.

Observed a large bin of fried chicken pieces that had been cooled in a deep container. Separate bulk foods when cooling into smaller, thin pans to help food cool rapidly.
