1. Observed sliced zucchini that was not date marked.
2. Observed dirt build-up under the three compartment sink.
3. Observed cracked and missing floor tiles in the kitchen area.
4. Observed molded IGA buns in the kitchen.
5. Observed upright cooler lights in the bar storage area that were not properly shielded.

ACTIONS TAKEN OR ORDERED

1. Bartender was informed that any sliced or cut produce must be date marked starting with the day it was first cut and must be discarded after seven (7) days.
2. Bartender was told to have the area under the three compartment sink cleaned.
3. Bartender was informed that the missing and cracked floor tiles must be repaired or replaced.
4. The bartender was told that the molded IGA buns must be discarded.
5. The bartender was informed that the lights in the upright cooler must be properly shielded.
