The purpose of the CCP inspection is to ensure employees are knowledgeable in general food safety to help prevent possible foodborne illness. Discussed critical controls during inspection. The following critical violations were noted:

## **VII. Cooking, Reheating, Cooling, Hot and Cold Holding**

Observed mini burgers(115°F) , ham (109°F), and grilled chicken (125°F) in the temperature danger zone. Hold all hot food above 135°F to limit growth of microorganisms that may cause illness. Operator discarded items during the inspection. Monitor hot holding temperatures to help prevent temperature violations.

## **XI. Protection from Contamination**

Observed raw beef and raw ground beef stored on shelf above cooked food and ready-to-eat food in walk-in meat cooler. Store all raw meat, ground meat, fish, or poultry separate or below from ready-to-eat food to protect from cross contamination that may cause illness. Operator began to discard possible contaminated food and reorganize food storage.

Observed several cooked foods in meat cooler not protected by covering or overhead protection. If food is being cooled on cooling racks and need to be left uncovered , ensure a tray or pan is placed on rack above food to help protect from possible contamination. Also, do not store pans of food on top of each other without placing lids on containers to protect food from contamination.
