VIOLATIONS NOTED

1. Observed debris build-up on walk-in cooler racks and on top of Herrek upright cooler.
2. Observed no soap or hand wash towels at the hand wash sink.
3. The cabinet lining in the cabinets above the three compartment sink was torn and dirty.
4. There were no test strips available in the facility.
5. Observed no thermometer in the cooler, along the bar that was storing the milk.
6. Observed a knife, used for cutting pizza, sitting out at room temperature, coated with food debris.

ACTIONS TAKEN OR ORDERED

1. Bartender was instructed to clean walk-in cooler racks and upright cooler.
2. Bartender was told that soap and hand towels must be available at all time at the hand wash sink.
3. Bartender was told to have the proper test strips available to monitor the sanitizer concentration in the three compartment sink and wiping cloth sanitizer.
4. A thermometer was immediately placed in the cooler holding the milk.
5. The bartender was told that a utensil used on ready to eat food must remain clean and cannot kept out at room temperature.

SANITARIAN'S SUMMARY OF INSPECTION

Cold holding temperatures appeared to be below 41 degrees F. Employees attempted to correct the above violations at the time of the inspection. All food that required date marking appeared to be date marked correctly.
