Violation(s) / Comment(s) (Chapter 3717-1 OAC violations checked)

Cold food held below 41°F and in proper temperature. Prep areas kept clean. Hot water adequate. The following violations were noted during the inspection:

04.4 Equipment, Utensils, and Linens: Maintenance and Operation

(A) Equipment - good repair and proper adjustment.

Door hinge on the storage cabinet is broken. Repair the door hinge to prevent further damage to the door. Equipment shall be in good repair.

04.2 Equipment, Utensils, and Linens: Numbers and Capacities

(I) Sanitizing solutions - testing devices.

Test strips not available for testing sanitizer concentration. A test kit or other device that accurately measures the concentration in ppm (mg/L) of sanitizing solutions shall be provided. Correct today.

(Critical) 04.6 Equipment, Utensils, and Linens: Sanitizing of Equipment and Utensils

(A) Food-contact surfaces and utensils.

Sanitizer not available for sanitizing food contact surfaces of utensils. Equipment food-contact surfaces and utensils shall be sanitized. Obtain and use for proper washing, rinsing, and sanitizing of food contact surfaces. Correct today

06.2 Physical Facilities: Numbers and Capacities

(B) Handwashing cleanser - availability.

Hand soap and hand towels not available for hand washing. Provide adequate supply of both hand soap and towels to wash hands. Each handwashing sink or group of two adjacent handwashing sinks shall be provided with a supply of hand cleaning liquid, powder, or bar soap. Correct today. Do not use handwash sink for disposal of liquid or for storing utensils.

Please remember to wash, rinse, and sanitize large items in main kitchen.
