1. Observed debris build-up in the Gibson upright refrigerator.
2. Observed a residential style refrigerator used in the facility.
3. Mechanical dish washing machine was not reaching at least 160 degrees F during the final rinse cycle.

ACTIONS TAKEN OR ORDERED

1. The refrigerator must be cleaned at a frequency to prevent debris build-up and must remain clean to sight and touch.
2. Once the residential refrigerator is removed from the facility, it must be replaced with an approved commercial unit.
3. The mechanical dish washing machine must be repaired so that it reaches at least 160 degrees F. or above during the final rinse cycle.

There were no critical violations at the time of the inspection. Cold holding temperatures appeared to be below 41 degrees F. The sanitizer in the three compartment sink appeared to be at the proper concentration at the time of inspection.
