**Violation(s) / Comment(s)** (Chapter 3717-1 OAC violations checked)

A complaint was reported to our office that an employee handled money and began to prepare food without washing their hands. During the inspection, did not observed employees handling money then food. Employees made an effort to use utensils to prevent barehand contact with ready-to-eat food. Spoke with management about complaint. Manager noted they have received complaint and have already taken action concerning complaint.

Standard inspection also conducted. Cold food held below 41°F and in proper temperature. Hot water adequate. Sanitizer in proper concentration of 200ppm quaternary ammonia. Food thermometer available. Food prep surfaces kept clean at time of inspection.

**06.4 Physical Facilities: Maintenance and Operation**

**(A) Repairing.**

An area of floor coving and tile in poor repair below the handsink and three compartment sink. Observed a small leak in handsink plumbing that may be creating water damage to coving and floor tile. Repair plumbing leaks and repair wall/ floor coving and damaged floor tile to prevent further damage to walls and floor. The physical facilities shall be maintained in good repair.

**(B) Cleaning - frequency and restrictions.**

Hard to reach areas of kitchen appeared dirty with debris and residue. Areas include door, walls, floor, ceiling of walk-in cooler; floor behind and underneath equipment, and ceiling above pizza oven. Clean hard to reach areas routinely or as often as necessary to keep them clean.
