Violation(s) / Comment(s) (Chapter 3717-1 OAC violations checked)

Cold food in proper temperature of 41°F or below. No hot food available at the time of inspection. Food prep areas appeared to be kept clean during inspection. Hot water adequate. Sanitizer in proper concentration.

06.1 Physical Facilities: Design, Construction, and Installation

(I) Light bulbs - protective shielding.

Light shield missing on light above food prep area. Lights in food prep areas shall be shielded to help protect food in case of light shatters.

(Critical) 03.4 Food: Limitation of Growth of Organisms of Public Health Concern

(F) Time/temperature controlled for safety food - hot and cold holding.

Pizza sauce held hot at 120°F and in temperature danger zone. Hold hot food above 135°F to limit growth of microorganisms that may cause illness. Ensure sauce is heated to proper temperature prior to placing into hot hold unit. Correct today.

05.1 Water, Plumbing, and Waste: Plumbing System

(S) Plumbing system - maintained in good repair.

Faucet on three compartment sink in poor repair. Repair to provide proper running water for both hot and cold faucets and to prevent leaks. Plumbing shall be in good repair.

04.5 Equipment, Utensils, and Linens: Cleaning of Equipment and Utensils

(A) Equipment, food-contact surfaces, nonfood-contact surfaces, and utensils.

Pizza oven, outside of dough mixer, racks in walk-in cooler, and some door seals / handles observed dirty with debris. Clean routinely to prevent such accumulation. Equipment shall be kept clean.
