VIOLATIONS NOTED

1. Observed soups in temperature danger zone between 65F to 105F. Soups being reheated improperly in the steam tables.
2. Food observed in the freezer beginning to thaw and at a temperature between 30F-33F.
3. Salad prep cooler and pantry coolers condensating water inside units.
4. Hard to reach areas of line equipment dirty with food debris and residue.
5. Skillets, baking sheets, and in-use food containers dirty with encrusted food debris.
6. Food prep sink plumbing and ice cream utensil sinks in poor repair.
7. Reach cooler next to flat grill holding food in temperature danger zone.

ACTIONS TAKEN OR ORDERED

1. Reheat food rapidly to 165F with-in 2 hours to destroy bacteria. Use equipment that is capable to rapidly reheat food such as the microwave or the stove.
2. Repair freezer so frozen food can remain frozen. All frozen food shall remain frozen in storage.
3. Repair salad cooler and pantry coolers to prevent condensation inside of units.
4. Clean hard to reach areas of equipment to prevent accumulation of food debris.
5. Clean in-use food storage containers daily. Clean skillets and pans of encrusted grease.
6. Repair ice cream scoop sinks food prep sink plumbing so sinks can be used as designed.
7. Operator adjusted thermostat on reach cooler to hold food below 41F.

SANITARIAN'S SUMMARY OF INSPECTION

Food prep areas kept clean to sight and touch. Sanitizer in proper concentration. Dish machine operating properly. Hot water adequate. Management and employees were cooperative in correcting violations at the time of inspection.
