### VIOLATIONS NOTED

1. Observed cold held food in the walk-in cooler in the temperature danger zone.
2. Walk-in cooler door does not create a tight seal when closed.
3. Beverage line equipment, soft serve machine, and hard to reach areas of front line equipment dirty to sight and touch.
4. The dish machine was not dispensing chlorine sanitizer at the time of inspection.
5. Flies observed in the kitchen, storage areas, and the drive thru area.

### ACTIONS TAKEN OR ORDERED

1. Repair and monitor the walk-in cooler to hold cold food at proper temperature.
2. Repair walk-in cooler door to close automatically when opened and to create a tight seal.
3. Clean beverage line equipment, soft serve machine, and hard to reach areas of equipment routinely throughout the day to prevent accumulation of residue from splash and spills.
4. Repair dish machine to dispense sanitizer at proper concentration to properly sanitize dishes and utensils.
5. Control flies by routine pest control and eliminating harborage conditions.

### SANITARIAN'S SUMMARY OF INSPECTION

Food prep areas kept clean to sight and touch at the time of inspection. Hot food held at proper temperature. Sanitizer for wipe cloths in proper concentration. Follow-up inspection will occur on July 23, 2008.
