

# Ross County Health District Food Service Inspection Summary

**Violation(s) / Comment(s)** (Chapter 3717-1 OAC violations checked)

1) Observed the kitchen and dining area floors in poor repair. The floors must be repaired or replaced so all parts of the floor are non-absorbent, smooth and easily cleanable. The owner stated that the floors are scheduled to be repaired on March 9, 2010.

**3717-1-06.4 Physical Facilities: Maintenance and Operation**

(A) Repairing.

The physical facilities shall be maintained in good repair.

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2) Observed wiping cloths sitting out on the counter with visible debris build-up. Wiping cloths must be stored in sanitizer (at the proper concentration) when not in use to prevent bacteria growth on the wiping cloths. Wiping cloths must also remain free of debris build-up.

**3717-1-03.2 Food: Protection from Contamination after Receiving**

(M) Wiping cloths - use limitation.

(2) Cloths that are in use for wiping counters and other equipment surfaces shall be:

(a) Held between uses in a chemical sanitizer solution at a concentration specified under paragraph (N) of rule 3717-1-04.4 of the Administrative Code; and

(b) Laundered daily as specified under paragraph (B)(4) of rule 3717-1-04.7 of the Administrative Code.

(5) Containers of chemical sanitizing solutions specified in paragraph (M)(2)(a) of this rule in which wet wiping cloths are held between uses shall be stored off the floor and used in a manner that prevents contamination of food, equipment, utensils, linens, single-service articles, or single-use articles.

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## SUMMARY

Complaint stated that the facility was dirty and the employees were not wearing gloves. The complaint appears to be invalid at the time of inspection. The facility did not appear to be dirty at the time of inspection and there was no food preparation at the time of inspection. Proper glove usage was discussed with the owner at the time of inspection.
