Violation(s) / Comment(s) (Chapter 3717-1 OAC violations checked)

A complaint was reported to our office that the facility has problems with roaches. Inspection conducted. Did not observe any signs of roaches at time of inspection. Operation was treated for pests on July 23, 2010. Continue routine pest control and keeping facility clean to help control pests.

A standard inspection was also conducted. Cold food sampled in proper temperature of 41°F or below. Hot food appeared to be cooked to proper temperature and held above 135°F. Sanitizer for warewashing and wiping cloths in proper concentration of 50-100ppm chlorine. Hot water adequate. Kitchen kept clean at time of inspection. Food thermometer, test strips, and single use gloves available.

(Critical) 03.2 Food: Protection from Contamination after Receiving

(C) Packaged and unpackaged food - preventing contamination by separation, packaging, and segregation.

Observed a water melon stored below raw meat in the walk-in cooler. Store all fresh produce or ready-to-eat food separate or above raw meat or raw food to protect from cross contamination that may cause illness. Correct today.

Observed several packages of dry ice cream toppings stored in cabinet below beverage station. Packages of toppings observed wet from water and liquid from beverage station. Store toppings in a location that is protect from possible contamination to protect food from contamination. Food should not be stored below sinks or drains or in sink cabinets. Violation corrected.

(Critical) 03.4 Food: Limitation of Growth of Organisms of Public Health Concern

(G) Ready-to-eat, time/temperature controlled for safety food - date marking.

Observed bulk portions of ready-to-eat pasta salad and seafood salad in walk-in cooler without datemarks. Also observed cut melons and fruit in cooler without datemarks. Date all ready-to-eat tcs food upon preparation so the food can be used within 7 days to limit growth of microorganisms that may cause illness. Correct today.

04.1 Equipment, Utensils, and Linens: Design and Construction

(KK) Food equipment - certification and classification.

Observed several bulk food containers used to store raw food, ready-to-eat food, and fried food that are not food grade. Obtain more food grade containers to store food that are durable and withstand everyday use. Food equipment that is acceptable for use in a food service operation or retail food establishment shall be approved by a recognized food equipment testing agency.

06.1 Physical Facilities: Design, Construction, and Installation

(M) Outer openings - protected.

The kitchen screen door has large gaps that may allow pests to enter facility. Enclose opening or replace screen door with a tight fitted door to help prevent entry of pests. Note: Floor tile and wall around door is also in poor repair and needs repaired to prevent entry of pests.
