VIOLATIONS NOTED

1. Hand wash towels were not available at one of the hand wash sinks in the kitchen area.
2. The doors to the walk-in cooler and freezer were not self closing and did not provide a tight seal.
3. Observed single use ice cream containers being reused as food storage containers in the walk-in refrigerator.
4. Observed residential style freezers and a refrigerator in the snack bar area.

ACTIONS TAKEN OR ORDERED

1. Hand wash towels must be available at all hand wash sinks in order to properly wash and dry hands.
2. The walk in doors must be repaired so that they are self closing and provide a tight seal.
3. The ice cream containers or any other single use containers cannot be reused as food storage containers.
4. Once the residential style refrigerator and freezers are removed from the facility, they must be replaced with approved commercial units.
