3. Women's restroom did not have a covered receptacle.
4. Facility had no test strips at the time of inspection.

ACTIONS TAKEN OR ORDERED

1. Utensils were removed from the hand wash sink.
2. Employee was instructed that once the plastic containers are emptied, they must be discarded and cannot be reused.
3. Employee was instructed to provide a covered receptacle in the women's restroom.
