1. Observed a residential style freezer being used in the facility.
2. Observed sliced ham that was not date marked.
3. Observed debris build-up on the seals of the prep cooler and upright refrigerator doors.

ACTIONS TAKEN OR ORDERED

1. Once the residential style freezer is removed, it must be replaced by an approved, commercial unit.
2. Once meat or produce is sliced, it must be dated starting with the day it was sliced and discarded after seven (7) days.
3. The seals on the prep cooler and upright refrigerator must be cleaned and remain clean .

SANITARIAN'S SUMMARY OF INSPECTION

Cold holding temperatures appear to be below 41 degrees F. Other than the cleaning violation above, the facility appears clean and well maintained.
