Violation(s) / Comment(s) (Chapter 3717-1 OAC violations checked)

Cold food sampled in proper temperature of 41°F or below. Hot food sampled appeared to be cooked to proper temperature and held above 135°F. Hot water adequate for hand washing and ware washing. Kitchen kept clean and orderly . The dish machine reached the proper hot water sanitation temperature. Sanitizer available for wiping cloths and in proper concentration. The following violations were noted during the inspection:

04.1 Equipment, Utensils, and Linens: Design and Construction

(K) Food temperature measuring devices - accuracy.

A food thermometer is available but is not calibrated. Calibrate food thermometer routinely to measure the temperature of food accurately. The operation serves thin food patties that require a thin probe food thermometer to accurately monitor internal temperatures. Obtain a thin probed food thermometer to accurately monitor the internal temperature of thin foods.

05.3 Water, Plumbing, and Waste: Sewage, Other Liquid Waste, and Rainwater

(C) Backflow prevention.

A funnel has been placed on the drain line of the food prep / three compartment sink and has eliminated the airgap on the sink. Remove funnel so the proper airgap is available to prevent backflow of sewage into sinks and to prevent migration of bacteria into sinks.
