VIOLATIONS NOTED

1. Observed debris build-up on kitchen shelves, in microwave oven, and kitchen walls.
2. Observed mold growth on walk-in cooler walls and ceiling.
3. No test strips were available at the time of inspection.
4. Observed several flies in the kitchen at the time of inspection.
5. Observed cut/sliced produce not properly date marked.
6. Observed chili stored in single use containers.
7. Observed an outdated half gallon of milk in the bar area.

ACTIONS TAKEN OR ORDERED

1. The above areas must be cleaned at a frequency to prevent debris build-up and remain clean to sight and touch.
2. The mold must be removed from the walk-in cooler walls and ceilings.
3. The proper test strips must be obtained.
4. The flies must be properly removed from the facility and the proper steps must be taken to prevent the re-emergence of the flies.
5. All cut/sliced vegetables must be properly date marked and discarded after seven days.
6. Food may only be stored in single use containers.
7. The outdated milk was discarded at the time of inspection.

SANITARIAN'S SUMMARY OF INSPECTION

The cold holding temperatures appeared to be below 41 degrees. A re-inspection is scheduled for September 3, 2008 to ensure that the above violations are corrected and the required cleaning is completed.
