VIOLATIONS NOTED

1. Sliced/cut vegetables still not date marked as instructed in the previous inspection.
2. Observed single use containers still being reused.
3. Observed debris build-up in upright cooler in bar area.
4. Observed a knife that is being used to slice pizza and subs sitting out on top to a cutting board.
5. Observed no thermometer in the upright cooler in the bar area.
6. Test strips still not available in the facility.

ACTIONS TAKEN OR ORDERED

1. All cut/sliced vegetables must be properly date marked and discarded after seven days.
2. Single use containers cannot be reused. They must be discarded after the original contents are used.
3. The upright cooler must be cleaned and remain clean to sight and touch.
4. When a utensil is used on ready to eat food must be stored and sanitized properly.
5. A thermometer must be placed in the upright cooler in the bar area.
6. Test strips must be available to properly monitor sanitizer concentrations.

SANITARIAN'S SUMMARY OF INSPECTION

The shelf above the dough machine has been cleaned. The microwave oven has been cleaned. The kitchen walls have been cleaned. The walk-in cooler walls have been cleaned and the wood shelves are in the process of being replaced.

A re-inspection is scheduled for September 18 to inspect the progress of correcting the above violations.
