### VIOLATIONS NOTED

1. Observed outdated milk, cottage cheese, and baby food in the store.
2. Observed sliced cheese that was not properly date marked.
3. Observed no thermometer in the upright deli cooler that was cold holding lunchmeat.
4. Observed food debris build-up in the bottoms of the upright freezers throughout the store.
5. Observed several cracked and chipped floor tiles in the deli area.

### ACTIONS TAKEN OR ORDERED

1. The outdated milk, cottage cheese, and baby food were taken off of the shelves.
2. The owner was informed that any sliced deli meat and/or cheese that is cut from the original package must be date marked from the first day it is cut or sliced.
3. The owner was instructed to place a thermometer in the upright cold holding unit that was storing the lunchmeat.
4. The owner was instructed to clean the bottoms of the upright freezers.
5. The owner was instructed to repair or replace the damaged floor tiles.
