Violation(s) / Comment(s) (Chapter 3717-1 OAC violations checked)

Cold food sampled in proper temperature of 41°F or above. Hot held food in proper temperature of 135°F. Sanitizer in proper concentration. Food prep surfaces kept clean at time of inspection. Dish machine reached proper hot water sanitizing temperature. The following violations were noted during inspection:

(Critical) 03.4 Food: Limitation of Growth of Organisms of Public Health Concern

(I) Time as a public health control.

Cooked hashbrowns sitting on counter and at 88°F and in temperature danger zone. Hashbrowns unmarked and not held under time control. Manager noted the standard procedure is to mark the food with a four hour time limit to prevent time and temperature abuse. Employee marked food with time to discard to prevent time and temperature abuse. Please remember, if this is a standard procedure, operation must be upgraded to a risk class IV for proper licensure. If food is held under time control, mark with time to discard four hours after removing from temperature control to prevent possible illness.

03.2 Food: Protection from Contamination after Receiving

(K) In-use utensils - between-use storage.

Ice cream utensil well not continuously running water at time of inspection. Observed build up of food debris in well. Ensure water is continuously running in well so water has sufficient velocity to flush particulates to the drain, if used with moist food such as ice cream.

04.5 Equipment, Utensils, and Linens: Cleaning of Equipment and Utensils

(A) Equipment, food-contact surfaces, nonfood-contact surfaces, and utensils.

Inside of cooling units, inside of oven, cooler door handles, hard to reach areas of equipment, and flour bins have an accumulation of food debris and residue. Clean equipment routinely of spills, splashes, and food debris to prevent such accumulation. Clean inside of baking equipment daily or as often as necessary to remove food debris.

Nonfood-contact surfaces of equipment shall be kept free of an accumulation of dust, dirt, food residue, and other debris.

06.4 Physical Facilities: Maintenance and Operation

(B) Cleaning - frequency and restrictions.

Walk-in freezer floor, dry storage room floor, and floor underneath equipment dirty with food debris. Clean routinely to prevent such accumulation. The physical facilities shall be cleaned as often as necessary to keep them clean.

05.4 Water, Plumbing, and Waste: Refuse, Recyclables, and Returnables

(P) Maintaining refuse areas and enclosures.

Dumpster enclosure has an accumulation of trash and debris on ground. Clean routinely to prevent such accumulation that may attract pests. Dumpster door open. Keep dumpster door closed to prevent access by pests. A storage area and enclosure for refuse, recyclables, or returnables shall be maintained clean and free of unnecessary items, as specified under paragraph (N) of rule 3717-1-06.4 of the Administrative Code.
