Follow-up inspection conducted. Counters and cabinets have been cleaned. Continue cleaning equipment, ice machine, ice bin, and equipment of debris. Chemicals stored away from food. Sanitizer available to sanitizer dishes and equipment. Single service cups stored off of the floor.

(Critical) 06.4 Physical Facilities: Maintenance and Operation

(K) Controlling pests.

Operation still needs to contact a licensed pest control company to have facility treated for pests. Still signs of rodent droppings under counters, shelves, on floor, and below sink.

06.4 Physical Facilities: Maintenance and Operation

(B) Cleaning - frequency and restrictions.

Floors, storage room, and hard to reach areas still need cleaned of dirt and debris. Continue cleaning restrooms and facilities daily.

04.2 Equipment, Utensils, and Linens: Numbers and Capacities

(I) Sanitizing solutions - testing devices.

Operation still needs to obtain test strips to monitor concentration of sanitizer.
