Violation(s) / Comment(s) (Chapter 3717-1 OAC violations checked)

Cold food sampled in proper temperature of 41°F or below. Hot food appeared to be cooked to proper temperature and held above 135°F. Hot water adequate. Sanitizer and test strips available. Food prep areas and equipment kept clean at time of inspection. Food thermometers available. Single use gloves and hair restraints in-use.

03.2 Food: Protection from Contamination after Receiving

(M) Wiping cloths - use limitation.

Sanitizer for wiping cloths in a low concentration less than 25ppm. Once wiping cloths are wet, store in sanitizer solution at a concentration specified under paragraph (N) of rule 3717-1-04.4 of the Administrative Code. Ideally concentration should be a minimum of 50-100ppm chlorine. Use test strips to monitor concentration when filling solution.

04.1 Equipment, Utensils, and Linens: Design and Construction

(KK) Food equipment - certification and classification.

Observed a non commercial microwave in kitchen. By March 1, 2011 all non commercial equipment must be replaced with NSF approved or equivalent equipment.

03.2 Food: Protection from Contamination after Receiving

(Y) Miscellaneous sources of contamination.

Fly lamp/ trap placed on top of milk cooler. Place insect trap in a location away from food or food prep areas to prevent possible contamination of food from dead insects. Food shall be protected from contamination that may result from a factor or source not specified under paragraphs (A) to (X) of this rule.
