Cold food sampled in proper temperature below 41°F. No hot food at time of inspection. Sanitizer, test strips, and food thermometer available. Kitchen kept clean and orderly. Vulcan stove has been installed since last inspection. Food dated. Operator completed person-in-charge training.

04.4 Equipment, Utensils, and Linens: Maintenance and Operation

(P) Warewashing equipment - determining chemical sanitizer concentration.

Sanitizer for spray bottles in a strong concentration greater than 500ppm quaternary ammonia. Measure with test strips when preparing solution and use between 200ppm and 400ppm as indicated by manufacturer to properly sanitize and prevent possible chemical contamination of food contact surfaces. Concentration of the sanitizing solution shall be accurately determined by using a test kit or other device. Violation corrected during inspection.
