

Level I Food Safety Training – Person-In-Charge

The Ross County Health District will be offering a level I food safety training for individuals who work in the food service industry on January 24, 2012 from 9a.m. until 11:00 a.m. at the Ross County Service Center, Conference room A, 475 Western Avenue, Chillicothe, OH 45601.

Our level I food safety training class is approved by the Ohio Department of Health as a person in charge training for any food employee in the State of Ohio. The level I food safety training is designed to provide training in food safety and sanitation for food service managers, head cooks, shift managers, or any food employee seeking training as a person in charge. Level II Food Safety Training – ServSafe

The Ross County Health District will be offering ServSafe, a level II food safety training approved by the Ohio Department of Health on January 27, 2012 and January 30, 2012 at the Ross County Senior Citizens Center from 8:00 am to 4:30 pm on both days. Registration for the class must be completed before January 20, 2012.
